Supported by Boys and Girls Club of Canada, our licensed program follows the “Power-Up and Torch Club” national curriculum as well as offering a variety of pro-social recreation and physical education activities. ‘The KidZone’ extends beyond child-minding to be an extended learning opportunity including arts, crafts, science, music programming, literacy, skiing, hiking, cooking and our Sprockids mountain biking program. We also ask the kids what activities they’d like to do!

All components of the program focus on providing the tools and environment necessary for young people to learn to set goals and create a plan for achievement, become more actively engaged and self-directed in their learning, learn co-operation, leadership and the effects of bullying, and become aware of their own health and nutrition. Along the way, the kids have a ton of fun!

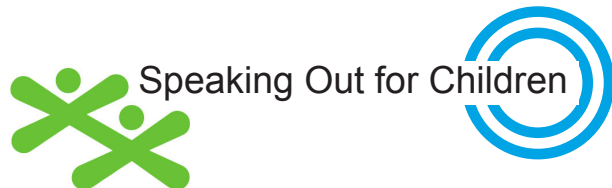
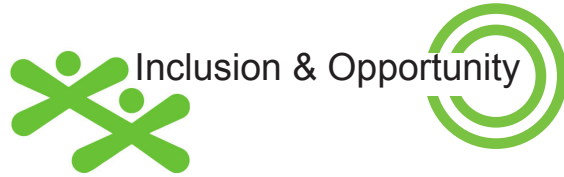

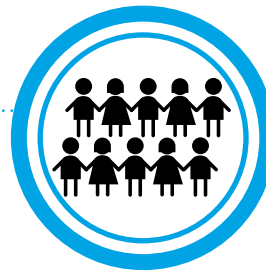
To provide a safe, supportive place where children and youth can experience new opportunities, overcome barriers, build positive relationships and develop confidence and skills for life.
